Project Description:

Cast in 1998, at LaFonderie de l'Atlantique in Nantes, France, this Peace Bell will be enclosed in a 52 foot glass enclosed tower in Millennium Monument World Peace Bell Pavilion in Newport, KY. The bell is inscribed "The World Peace Bell is a symbol of freedom and peace, honoring our past, celebrating our present and inspiring our future." It's decorated with highlights of the last millennium and designs symbolizing world peace.

Coating Selection Explanation:

The structural steel holding up this World Peace Bell is coated with Carboline System Carbozinc 859, Carboguard 888 and Carbothane 134 HG because of its durability and weathering abilities.
